
Detroit's Finest Entertainment

In 2019, we welcomed Andrew Lloyd Webber to Detroit as he put the finishing touches on the U.S. premiere of *Love Never Dies*.

When you bring your group to one of our great shows, you're giving them an outstanding Broadway experience right here in the Motor City. We're constantly improving your visit to the Fisher Theatre. Our expanded lobby bar enhances this beautiful space and helps us deliver faster, more efficient service to guests, both pre-show and at intermission. The opulently appointed Ambassador Lounge, available 90 minutes before the performance, provides a first-class experience and is catered by our friends at Mongers' Provisions, an incredible local culinary outfitter. VIP guests can relax in the Fisher Lounge, with private restrooms and reserved bar service in its comfortable, relaxed setting. The two Overlooks view the striking Grand Lobby. These private enclaves are for intimate groups of 2 (the 1928 Overlook) or up to 6 (the 1961 Overlook). More information on these Overlooks is on page 23.

Other updates are railings on our balcony steps and an improved sound system. We added more than 20 speakers to ensure guests on the balcony hear as clearly as those on the main floor. In addition, the Detroit Opera House has two high-speed elevators in the lobby that enable guests to reach the balcony easily.

- Pay by Credit Card: Please email BroadwayInDetroitGroups@ATGEntertainment.com with your final count and cell phone number. We will call you for your credit card information as soon as we are able, Monday-Friday, before 5pm.
- Pay in Person: If you intend on paying in person, please contact Group Sales at least one business day in advance Monday-Friday to schedule an appointment by emailing BroadwayInDetroitGroups@ATGEntertainment.com for hours we are available. We accept payment by cash (exact change only), one check* or money order made out to ATG Detroit or one credit card. (*Last date to accept a check is 10 business days before your performance). Final payment for group tickets must be received no later than the due date specified unless other arrangements have been made through the Group Sales Office in advance. Once tickets have been paid for and pulled from our system, any reserved tickets not sold will be released and your account will be closed. Any additional tickets needed will be filled on a best-available basis at the time of payment. There are no discount group tickets sold on the day of the event or after Group Sales Office hours.
