The final sentence of the first paragraph should read as follows (amendment in **bold**):

Based on her assessed needs, residential care would cost **£1,000** per week.

The calculation should read as follows (amendment in **bold**):

Cost of care	£1,000.00
Add PEA	£30.15
Less Ahmet's income (£15,000 ÷ 52)	(£288.46)
Less Ahmet's tariff income	(£11.00)
Local authority contribution	= £730.69
