Be aware

The UK Government's guidance on rehabilitation periods state that the following applies:

- A custodial sentence of more than four years can become spent, provided the offence is not listed under Schedule 18 of the Sentencing Act 2020, which includes serious offences such as violent or sexual crimes.
- The rehabilitation period depends on the length of the custodial sentence and starts from the end of the sentence including the licence period.
