Be aware

The UK Government's guidance on rehabilitation periods state that the following applies:

- A custodial sentence of more than four years can become spent, provided the offence is not listed under Schedule 18 of the Sentencing Act 2020, which includes **serious offences such as violent or sexual crimes**.
- The rehabilitation period depends on the length of the custodial sentence and starts from the end of the sentence including the licence period.
