William Bentinck, 4th Duke of Portland

I am the 4th Duke of Portland and I own most of the land around Sutton, Kirkby and Mansfield.

I care a lot about local businesses and the poor people.

I think that the railway is a good idea because it will help local businesses sell their goods further afield and bring coal into the area to fuel the factories.

The Bentinck memorial in the middle of Mansfield marketplace is dedicated to my son, William. It will help people in the future remember how much my family contributed to Mansfield's prosperity.

John Coke

My name is John Coke and I come from a wealthy family who live in Pinxton. My father was the Reverend D'Ewes Coke who owned the coal mines at Pinxton.

I took over the family's business interests when my father died in 1811.

Pinxton has a lot of coal beneath the ground and I realised that I could make more money if there was a railway to transport it to the factories around Mansfield.

John Coke laid the cornerstone for the new Mansfield Town Hall in 1836. The inscription can still be clearly seen.

My father is known as the "father of civil engineering". He designed many of the canals around the country.
