1848 timetable:

This was for the Midland Leen Valley Railway from 1848 to 1849. During this year the steam railway hadn't been finished to Mansfield, and The Summit (Kirkby) was as far as the train went; passengers had to change to the horse-drawn coach to finish their journey to Mansfield.
