Welcome to Mill Waters, where you can exercise, socialise or simply breathe in the sights and sounds of the various wildlife that thrive in the habitats in and around the Reservoir.

Why not head down to the northern end of the site to view the Terns as they hover above the water, before plunging down for a fish; listen out for the distinctive call of the Chiff Chaff or observe the Grey Heron, which feasts on the fish and small mammals at Hermitage Pond?

Many of these mills were created when the water-powered frame was invented during the Industrial Revolution, leading to a boom in the manufacture of textiles in Sutton during the mid-1800s.
