- 6,700 m long sea walls

- 1: 2011-2022 | Saint-Denis - La Grande Chaloupe (9.4 km)
- 2: 2022-2027 | La Grande Chaloupe - La Possession (3 km)

The project



This is one of the largest road construction projects on a viaduct, which represents a real technical feat.

The goal: to improve traffic safety between the two main economic centres of the island in an area exposed to natural risks (rock falls along the island's cliffs, cyclonic winds, etc.)

Our value creation

▪ A sustainable solution

The coastal viaduct has been designed to last at least 100 years and support a tramway line in the future

▪ Eco-friendly engineering

Almost 150 measures have been implemented to mitigate the project impacts:

- use of bubble curtains to control the noise generated on the worksite
- water quality monitoring
- installation of coral-support mechanisms, etc.



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
