Egis is set to continue the supervision of works for 2 more sections of Braşov – Târgu Mureş – Cluj – Oradea Motorway Project

Egis has been appointed by the National Company for Administration of Road Infrastructure – CNAIR S.A. to supervise the "Design and Build Contract for Braşov – Târgu Mureş – Cluj – Oradea Motorway, Subsection 3A2: Nădăşelu - Mihăileşti (km 8+700 - km 25+500) and Subsection 3B1: Mihăileşti- Zimbtor (km 0+000- km 13+260)"

During the second half of November, Egis signed a 5.8 million-euro contract with the National Company for Administration of Road Infrastructure to provide additional supervision services for the design and build of 30-km sections of Braşov – Târgu Mureş – Cluj – Oradea Motorway, between Nădăşelu and Zimbtor.

Subsubsections 3A1 and 3B2 are designed for a speed of 120 km/h. The entire 3A2 subsection develops on the administrative territory of Cluj county, crossing the jurisdiction of Gârbău (km 8+700 - km 13+100) and Sinpaul (km 13+100 - km 25+500) localities, whereas the 3B1 subsection crosses the administrative territory of both Cluj and Sălaj counties, or the jurisdiction of Sinpaul (km 0+000 - km 0+920) and Zimbtor (km 0+920- km 13+260) localities. The 2 subsections of this strategically important motorway project are particularly challenging from a technical perspective as they cross a variety of terrain types ranging from plains, valleys, hills to mountains and involve complex structural and consolidation works, such as a large number of viaducts, overpasses and bridges as well as retaining walls and soil reinforcement by bored piles.

"Egis is always drawn to technically complex projects, such as these particular motorway sections, as we aim not only to challenge ourselves continuously but also to maintain and develop the great skills of our professionals offering them stimulating tasks to undertake. This new supervision contract adds up to other missions on 2 more subsections of the Braşov – Târgu Mureş – Cluj – Oradea motorway which makes things more exciting as our contribution to the project becomes more important every day. With such a portfolio, we are eager to attract more highly experienced engineers into such projects", said Manuela Copcea, Manager of Supervision and Project Management Department at Egis in Romania.

The contract shall cover high-quality supervisory services to ensure the Contractor complies with contract obligations, including correct use of funds, and optimal duration, cost and overall quality.

The duration of the contract is 36 months to supervise the design and build of the motorway works plus the duration of the supervision during the works warranty period.
