Egis to support XP Asset Management with new concession contracts for two leading General Aviation airports and heliports in Brazil

Egis will support the new concessionaire XP Asset Management (XP) with running the two main business airports in Brazil, when XP takes over from Infraero, the public operator, in 2023. Jacarepaguá Airport in Rio de Janeiro and Campo de Marte in São Paulo are dedicated to business and general aviation, with ca. 130,000 movements per annum between them and substantial helicopter operations.

The Egis proposition draws on its extensive experience as a partner and airport operator in more than 18 other airports around the world, its local presence in Brazil for more than 40 years, and its track record as a top ten Engineering Consulting company there.

The shared vision for the two airports focuses on sustainability, resilience, and the opportunities presented by near future urban air mobility developments such as eVTOL aircraft, where Brazil is among the most advanced countries to see this new transport mode emerge.

The first phase of Egis activity will concentrate on:

- Coordinating operations and resources – from infrastructure to staff
- Improving airport efficiency and service quality
- Ensuring safety, security and environmental compliance

Commenting on the new contract, Leonardas Mitrulius, CEO of Egis in Brazil said: “XP Asset Management is one of the most significant infrastructure investors currently in Brazil. This is a fantastic win for Egis, which places us at the heart of exciting developments in mobility and sustainability in the country’s two largest cities. The airports of Jacarepaguá and Campo de Marte are ideally placed to exploit these emerging trends and prepare for the innovations they bring.”

Frédéric Mor, COO Aviation of Egis added: “We expect helicopter operations to gradually move towards electric powered eVTOL aircraft. These are quieter and with clear environmental benefits, especially given that 69% of Brazil’s electricity is generated by renewables – with the majority from hydropower.”
