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Siemens Gamesa, Arise and Foresight team up again for new Swedish project

- The 277-MW Kölvallen wind farm will feature 41 units of the SG 6.6-170 turbine and one SG 6.6-155 machine
- The project is Foresight Energy Infrastructure Partners' tenth and largest investment to date
- The project is expected to be installed in early 2025, and will be covered by a 35-year service agreement to ensure optimal operations

Siemens Gamesa, Arise and Foresight Group will collaborate for another major project in Sweden using the company's most competitive onshore platform, the Siemens Gamesa 5.X. The project has been acquired by Foresight Energy Infrastructure Partners, Foresight Group's flagship energy transition fund.

The 277-MW Kölvallen project is due to be installed in early 2025 and will feature 41 units of the SG 6.6-170 model and one SG 6.6-155. The wind farm will stand close to the Skaftåsen project led by the three companies and is currently being installed. Skaftåsen was the first to use the Siemens Gamesa 5.X platform, one of the most competitive in terms of Levelized Cost of Energy (LCoE) in the onshore landscape.

The contract between the parties is also noteworthy for its lengthy 35-year service contract, assuring the machines operate to the best of their capacities over their lifetime. They will sit on towers of 135 meters for the SG 6.6-170 turbines, and on a 122.5-meter tower for the SG 6.6-155 version.

NORD/LB has provided a financing package as sole MLA to support the construction of the wind farm with Foresight being advised by Newsec Infra on the debt raise.

Heiko Ludwig, Global Head Structured Finance at NORD/LB, commented: "we are extremely pleased to have supported Foresight and Arise in the financing of this landmark project, deploying the latest Siemens technology. The Nordics are a prominent market for renewables and we are committed to provide innovative solutions to accelerate the energy transition."

Theodora Forbes, Senior Investment Manager at Foresight, added: "we are delighted to be expanding our presence in Sweden, alongside Arise and SGRE, with this addition to FEIP's growing portfolio. Kölvallen and Skaftåsen are milestone onshore wind projects for the Nordic region with each making a significant contribution to the region's decarbonisation targets. As demand for secure

energy grows, exacerbated by ongoing geopolitical events, FEIP is well positioned to support the build-out of Europe's low-carbon energy system."

Clark MacFarlane, CEO of Siemens Gamesa's operations in Northern Europe and the Middle East, said: *"this project feels like an extension to the Skaftåsen project, being physically close, and allowing us to work alongside our partners Arise and Foresight to extend our collaboration further. This project is another strong endorsement for the Siemens Gamesa 5.X platform. Between Skaftåsen and Kölvallen, the two wind farms will provide significant green energy for Sweden."*

Per-Erik, Eriksson CEO at project developer Arise, added: "we are happy to realize another great project with Foresight and Siemens Gamesa. The wind farm will produce almost 1 TWh of renewable power per year, which is a material contribution to the Swedish power balance and an important measure to mitigate climate change."
