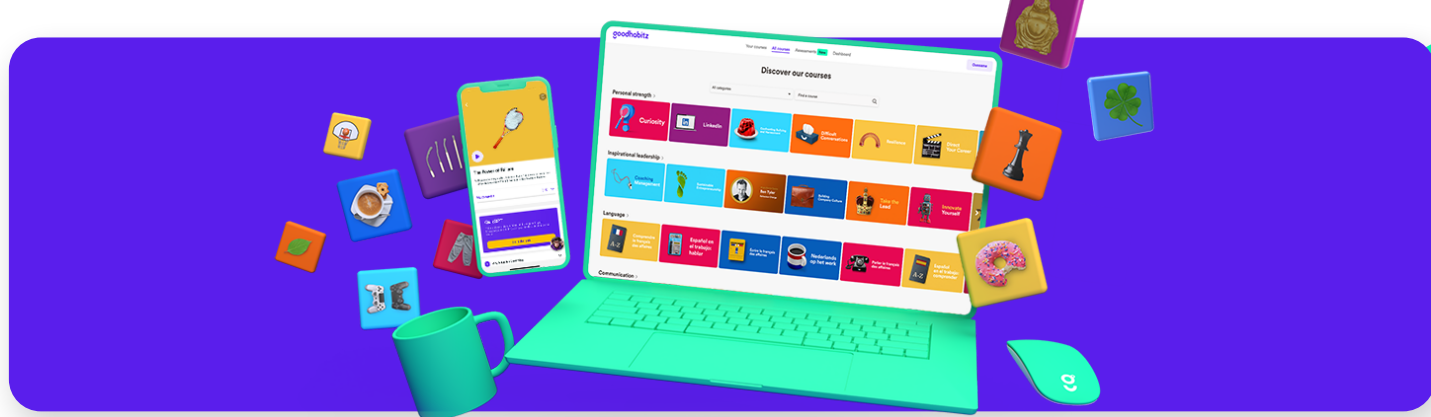
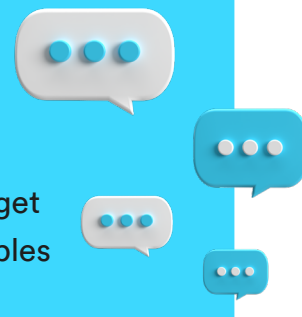


Challenge:

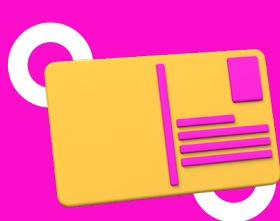
Stimulating mutual understanding and providing an accessible way to address topics that arise in the workplace within a team setting.
