A hate crime is when someone is targeted because of who they are; or who they are believed to be.

This could be based on:

- Race
- Religion
- Sexual orientation
- Disability
- Transgender identity

Hate crimes can include:

- Verbal abuse
- Threats
- Physical attacks
- Damage to your home or belongings.

If you experience a hate crime:

- Report it to the police: call **101** or report it online
- Get a reference number from the police
- Tell us: call our customer service centre on **0345 141 4663** and give us the police reference number

Your Housing Manager will investigate and support you.

We take hate crime seriously.

If you are found to have committed a hate crime, this may lead to action being taken against your tenancy.
