BRICKLIVE BRITANNIA is an exciting interactive toy brick experience that takes visitors through British History from the Stone Age to the 21st Century. With 17 stunning models, including the show stopping 8m long model of the Flying Scotsman, this show contains some of the most charming and fascinating toy brick builds ever created.

Visitors can experience a walk through time, with many of the exhibits being dioramas that depict everyday life, as well as famous moments in British History.

The Flying Scotsman is enhanced by the inclusion of lighting, sound effects and steam coming from the train's funnel. Information boards with all the models allow guests to learn more about the history of the UK, as well as telling visitors all about the builds and how they were created. This tour is an indoor asset and is absolutely ideal for smaller venues that require slightly smaller models.







CASE STUDY



NOVIUM MUSEUM, CHICHESTER

Iconic moments in British history from the Stone Age to the 21st Century, were presented in toy brick form at The Novium Museum in Summer 2018.

Britannia: A History of Britain in toy bricks, featured more than 15 stunning models, including a show stopping 8 m long model of the Flying Scotsman, the world's most famous steam locomotive, with light, sound and smoke effects.

The Novium Museum also gave visitors the chance to see their own brick creations on display alongside the main models. Budding builders were invited to create an iconic moment in the history of Britain, and enter one of three age categories.
