FOREWORD

In June 2019, we announced our plan to host Formula E in Cape Town with the Executive Mayor of the City of Cape Town. On 25 February 2023, we delivered the first Formula E race in sub-Saharan Africa!

This journey has transformed how we plan events in South Africa. Despite the challenges posed by the Covid-19 pandemic, we used the three years to create platforms that have catalysed the growth of the Green Economy. We are proud to have become advocates for the green economy.

The results of our efforts are evident:

- 1. We launched our purpose-led campaign, Go Green Africa, with Uber South Africa and Western Cape Government as founding partners.
- 2. We hosted Africa's Green Economy Summit, which saw a provisional USD 2 million commitment to an African project on the first day of the Summit.
- 3. We launched Formula Student Africa, which will see students from six universities accelerate the growth of e-mobility and sustainability industries in Africa.
- 4. The Cape Town Stadium Precinct is now a multifunctional destination with one of the fastest, most picturesque tracks on the Formula E circuit.
- 5. The 7.68km of concrete barriers and fences were entirely built in South Africa, a testament to our local construction industry.
- 6. Cape Town benefitted from an indirect socio-economic impact from the event of R1.018 billion.

None of this would have been possible without the trust, partnership, and support of our stakeholders Formula E Operations, the City of Cape Town, the Western Cape Government, and the hundreds of individuals involved in the event's delivery.

When we began this journey, I guaranteed the Founders of Formula E, Alejandro Agag and Alberto Longo, that we would create a top-three race on their ABB FIA Formula E World Championship calendar. I trust we have made an impression and look forward to hosting many more Cape Town races.



INTRODUCTION

- The inaugural 2023 Cape Town E-Prix was the 1st open wheel race to take place in Sub Saharan Africa since 1993. With Cape Town securing a 5year contract with the FIA and Formula E, it marks the beginning of a new frontier of motor racing in South Africa.
- Excitement was abound and the atmosphere was electric in and around the circuit as spectators waited to watched the fastest and most powerful Formula E car to date hit the streets of the Mother City for the first time.
- Attendees dubbed the event a 'Proudly South African' moment.
- As a destination with ambitions to become a Green Economy hub, the event is a demonstration of the region's willingness and ability to transform to a greener future.





The Cape Town E-Prix pulled in the crowds as the Mother City put on its best for a global audience, and it did not disappoint.

EVENT PRECINCT

- The 2023 Cape Town E-Prix took place in the existing event precinct around the Cape Town Stadium.
- The suitability of the precinct was identified following a site inspection undertaken with representatives of Formula E and the local host city promoter E-Movement (Pty) Ltd between 9 - 12 September 2019 following which a suitable track was identified.
- In consideration of the track layout and how it might fit within the existing fabric of the precinct, a holistic approach was taken to enhance the precinct to to create a multifunctional facility that meets the needs and requirements of the precinct and those required host an E-Prix.
- Following the City of Cape Town Council resolution passed in June 2022 to upgrade the precinct, track designers PJA and Nadeson Consulting worked extensively with the City of Cape Town on a mutually beneficial track design that met all the objectives of a multi-functional venue that kept true to the original landscape master plan and facilitated its evolution from its 2010 FIFA World Cup legacy.
- The precinct upgrades began in April 2022 and were completed on schedule in January 2023.
- The result is a legacy of an upgraded multifunctional precinct with one of the fastest, most picturesque tracks on the Formula E circuit.



CAPE TOWN E-PRIX STREET CIRCUIT

- Table Mountain and Robben Island formed the backdrop to the new Cape Town E-Prix street circuit.
- The drivers hailed the track as a challenging performance and speed wise due to multiple high-speed corners.
- The track rewarded aggressive driving which led to some of the best overtakes and plenty of racing action.






OUTRAGEOUS OVERTAKES SEAL MEMORABLE DA COSTA WIN IN CAPE TOWN.

The race along Cape Town's coastline saw 30 laps of nonstop action. Championship leader, Pascal Wehrlein exited the race after a collision on the opening lap and pole sitter, Sasha Fenestraz, crashed into the wall on the final lap. The new track claimed its place as the fastest track in Formula E, delivering a memorable race that resulted in two full course yellow flags and only 13 drivers finishing the race.

However, it was all eyes on Portuguese driver, Antonio Felix da Costa, throughout the race as he delivered a stunning drive from 11th on the grid to take his first ever victory with TAG Heuer Porsche. Da Costa produced not one, but two of the best overtakes to have ever been seen. Da Costa made the daring overtake at trickiest part of the track, a high speed 3-turn combo that saw three crashes earlier that weekend. After missing the activation of his Attack Mode, da Costa handed Vergne the lead into the closing stage of the race. It was a close race right to the chequered flag, but da Costa managed to recreate his previous move to overtake Vergne and take the win.



IMPACT

- On Friday 24 February, Premier Alan Winde led a Track Ride on electric bikes supplied by the Official E-Bike Supplier of the 2023 Cape Town E-Prix, Green Riders.
- Green Riders is a company which is disrupting and revolutionizing the last-mile delivery space for fast food and small goods in South Africa. Green Riders has introduced a fleet of e-bicycles (e-bikes) to the South African market which are environmentallyfriendly (green), cost-effective (much cheaper to operate than ICE vehicles).
- Green Riders aims to create 50,000 jobs in the last-mile delivery sector over the next few years.
- Green Riders loaned 19 bikes to City of Cape Town Traffic Officers for use around the race precinct the week before and at the race.
- In addition, the event was promoted on the Green Riders Box in the lead up to the event.
- Green Riders is a local South African innovation embracing the challenge to transform to greener solutions.
