We want all of our visitors to have an amazing day here at Longleat. Signs are located around the park to highlight crowded spaces, hot areas and core accessibility information.

Explore Longleat House

On the advice of the fire service, only two wheelchair users are allowed on any floor so we can accommodate four wheelchairs in the House at a time; this allows for one wheelchair per tour. Longleat Railway







All aboard! Enjoy the incredible views as you trundle along the edge of Half Mile Pond. Trains run every 30 minutes from 11am and the journey lasts approximately 12 minutes. There is a specially adapted carriage that can accommodate one wheelchair user and their companion.

Safari Bus service





The Safari Bus service* is available on a first come first served basis. There is one wheelchair space on the bus which will need to be booked in advance. More information at Guest Services in Main Square. A hearing loop is also available on the bus.

Jungle Cruise







Take a voyage of discovery! Cruise past our Colobus monkeys and our band of western lowland gorillas. Meet our NEW pod of hippos. You can even feed our Californian sea lions!* Boats run from 10am – park close (subject to daylight hours).

It is accessible for wheelchair users and

those with limited mobility. We can accommodate up to four wheelchair users per boat. Dogs, including service dogs, are not allowed on the cruise for welfare reasons.

Adventure Castle



The Adventure Castle is wheelchair and pushchair friendly. Accessible play equipment for those in a wheelchair, such as a wheelchair swing, is available. Some equipment may not be accessible for wheelchair users or those with limited mobility.









Hedge Maze

We regret that our Hedge Maze is not accessible for wheelchairs.

Please note, there are over a mile and a half of paths to choose from within the maze, so this can take between 20 - 90 minutes to navigate. Vulnerable guests should be accompanied at all times.

Other attractions

Access to some of our attractions is historic and may be via cobbled pathways, steps or steep ramps.

African Village



This is where you can get out of the car and get closer to the animals.



Wander through our lemur enclosure and enjoy spectacular views of the East African Reserve. Please note the lemur enclosure is accessible via a gravel path.

Our Look Out, where you can come face to face with our African painted dogs, can be accessed via a ramp.

Both our refreshment area – The Watering Hole Café – and African Traders Shop are also accessible.



Queue Assist Scheme

We understand that some guests require additional assistance to be able to fully enjoy their visit.

Any guest wishing to use a Queue Assist Scheme pass can request this from Guest Services, located in the Main Square. The Pass Holder must be accompanied by a responsible individual over the age of 14 and standard attraction rules and restrictions will apply.

A maximum of four individuals will be allowed to accompany the Queue Assist Scheme pass holder at each attraction and the Queue Assist Scheme pass holder must be present with their pass at all times.

Facilities

There are seven accessible toilets located around the park including a toilet with a hoist (located near Lord Bath's Sweet Shop). A radar key is available from Guest Services.
