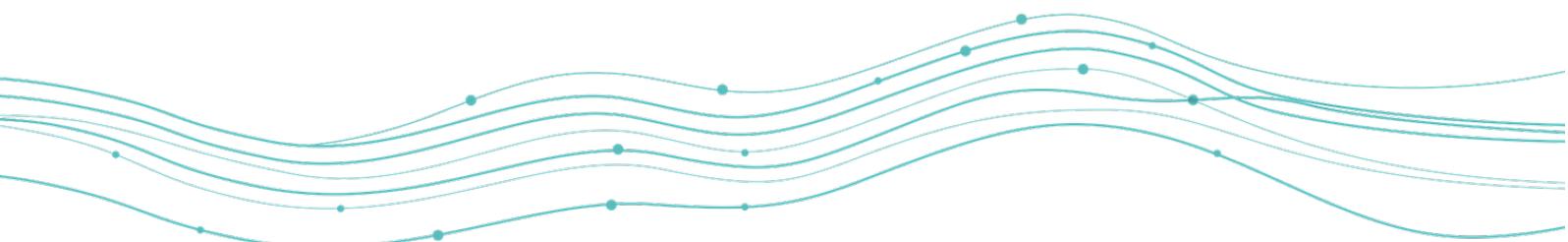

1. Introduction to our Cookie Policy

The Quanta Group (Holdings) Limited is a private limited company registered in England & Wales. This Cookie Policy explains how The Quanta Group (excluding Craven Street Wealth), along with Novia Financial Plc (trading as "Wealthtime and Copia Capital Management") and Wealthtime Limited (trading as "Wealthtime Classic"), collectively referred to as "The Quanta Group", uses cookies and similar technologies to recognise you when you visit the following websites:

How often will we update the Cookie Policy?

We may update this Cookie Policy when we change our use of cookies or introduce new cookies or for legal or regulatory reasons. The date at the top of this Cookie Policy indicates when it was last updated.

2. What are cookies?

A web cookie (also known as a HTTP cookie, browser or internet cookie) is a small text file containing a string of characters that are sent to your computer when you visit a website. When you visit the website again, the cookie allows that site to recognise your browser.

Cookies may store user preferences and other information. They may also act as a convenience feature, designed to save you time by informing the web server that you have returned to a specific page you've visited previously.

Why do we use them?

Our websites use cookies to distinguish you from other users. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and allows us to improve the site. There are different types of cookies, with different functions. Whilst some are required for technical reasons to keep our websites functioning (such as "Strictly necessary" cookies), other types of cookies enable us to track the interests of our users and provide relevant content, to enhance the user experience on our websites.

3. Types of cookies

Cookies are categorised differently, by different websites. This includes:

By origin:

This is who the cookies are set by.

- **First party cookies** - Cookies set by the website owner. (i.e. The Quanta Group)
- **Third party cookies** - Cookies set by parties other than the website owner. They enable third party features or functionality to be provided via our websites for example, interactive content, contact form functionality, advertising or analytics). The third party who sets these third-party cookies can recognise your computer, both when it visits the website in question and when it visits certain other websites.

By duration:

A cookie consent banner may use both session and persistent cookies. The session cookies will remember your choice within your current visit, whilst the persistent cookie will remember your choice across multiple visits.

- **Session cookies** - These are temporary cookies that exist only for the duration of a single browsing session. They are deleted once you close your web browser.
- **Persistent cookies** - These cookies remain on your device for a longer, specified period. They store information until their expiration date, or until you delete them. These can keep you logged into your favourite websites or remember preferences for returning visitors.

By function:

The Quanta Group utilises the following cookies across each of our websites (excluding cravenstreetwealth.com):

- **Strictly necessary**
- **Analytics / performance**
- **Targeting**

You can find out more about each of these cookie functions and how we use them within the Quanta Group, across all our websites.

4. How do we use cookies?

- **Strictly necessary cookies** - These cookies are essential for our website to function properly and therefore are always active when browsing the site*. Whilst they do not store any personally identifiable information, they do allow us to save your cookie preferences and enable security features, using tools such as GDPR Cookie Compliance and Cloudflare.

You can block these through your browser settings manually, but this may impact your website experience, and we won't be able to save your preferences; meaning each time you visit our website, you'll need to enable or disable cookies again.

- **Analytics / performance cookies** - These cookies allow us to collect anonymous, aggregated information through tools such as Google Analytics*, to better understand how you interact with our website. This allows us to measure and improve site performance by tracking key metrics such as views, traffic sources and other user behaviour, including most visited pages. Disabling these cookies may affect certain features and prevent us from gaining essential insight into how we can improve the overall user experience for clients, customers and partners alike.

You can reject Google Analytics cookies by rejecting the Analytical / Performance category within our Cookie consent manager, however this will reject all cookies within this category. Alternatively, you can opt out of being tracked by Google Analytics across all websites (including our websites) by visiting <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>

- **Targeting cookies** - These cookies help us provide you with more relevant and tailored marketing content, based on your browsing activity on our website. We may share this data with advertising partners to deliver sponsored content via targeted placements on other websites online. We may also employ technology used to measure the effectiveness of these advertisements, this will involve adding floodlight pixels and tags to our online channels, to collect supplementary data for enhanced relevance and targeting. Whilst these cookies don't store personally identifiable information, such as name and contact details (unless you choose to provide this), they work by uniquely identifying your browser and device. If you disable these cookies, we won't be able to show you tailored advertising content; for example, goods and services you may be interested in.

You can reject Google Ads cookies by rejecting the Targeting category within our Cookie consent manager; however this will reject all cookies within this category. Alternatively, you can manage the ads Google shows you by navigating to <https://myadcenter.google.com/>

5. How long are they stored for?

Below are some rough guidelines to the duration of our cookie functions.

Cookie function	Cookie storage duration
Strictly necessary	This type of cookie only lasts for the duration of time that you are interacting with the website. It will expire when you exit the site, or automatically when you stop interacting with it.
Analytics / performance	Some cookies will expire when the site is closed, but others may have longer lifespans.
Targeting	Some cookies will expire when the site is closed, but others may have longer lifespans.

6. What is the purpose of each cookie used?

The cookies used across our websites may differ depending on your browsing activity and behaviour, therefore not all cookies listed below will always be used. You can find the details of each cookie and how they are used below.

7. How can I control cookies?

When you first visit any of our websites, you will be notified of our use of cookies and presented with a consent management tool on the screen, giving you the opportunity to accept or reject cookies.

Please note:

- If you have visited any of our websites and accepted all cookies, these cookies will be stored on your browser, and we will have remembered these preferences. Therefore, if you access the site again, it won't ask you to confirm the preferences. However, you can manually change your settings whenever you like. You can find more details below under '*How to change your cookie preferences**'.
- You will not be able to reject Strictly necessary (Essential) cookies, as the website will not function without them. These cookies can only be disabled by changing your browser preferences manually.
- Each of our websites use a different consent management tool and will use slightly different cookies depending on website and marketing activity, so these may not appear the same. Please refer to 'What is the purpose of each cookie used?' above for more information.

*How to change your cookie preferences

Once your cookies have been selected and saved on your first visit, you can exercise your right to amend your cookie preferences by changing the Cookie settings, at any time.
