Thank you for your Official Information Act (OIA) request, received on 5 September 2024. You requested:

"All documents and correspondence between 1 October 2023 and now - including but not limited to emails, briefings, aide memoire, file notes, minutes, and letters - held, created or received by the Commission relating to specific proposed Waste-to-Energy projects (including but not limited to the projects proposed for Kaipara or Waimate) or Waste-to-Energy plants in general."

Searches of our records for various keywords and categories have not identified any information relevant to your request. Accordingly, I am refusing your request under section 18(e) of the OIA as the information sought does not exist.

The Infrastructure Commission has created and maintains a National Infrastructure Pipeline. The Pipeline is a compilation of infrastructure project information collected from many contributing organisations. It includes a search tool which you can use to find information about specific projects in the sectors and regions of interest to you.
