Thank you for your Official Information Act request, received on 30 September 2024. You requested:

"1. I note you have a highly redacted document on the review of the Dunedin hospital build. Why are the important financial figures redacted? I would like to contact those involved and discuss this document. Without the financial figures this document is a waste of time. I also note that the writer is very skilled at interviewing his typewriter, but the document is pretty much crap. This is where the money goes.

2. What did this report cost?"

We have interpreted your request to relate to the report titled *New Dunedin Hospital Review: Independent Expert Readiness Review* and published in a redacted form on our website here: <a href="https://tewaihanga.govt.nz/our-work/reviews/dunedin-hospital-independent-review">https://tewaihanga.govt.nz/our-work/reviews/dunedin-hospital-independent-review</a>. The parts of your request have been numbered for ease of reference below.

For part 1 of your request, it was necessary to withhold some information in the *New Dunedin Hospital Review: Independent Expert Readiness Review* (the Report) under one or more of the following sections of the Official Information Act:

- 9(2)(g)(i): to protect the free and frank expression of opinions by departments
- 9(2)(i): to enable a Minister of the Crown or any public service agency holding the information to carry out commercial activities without prejudice or disadvantage
- 9(2)(j): to avoid prejudice to negotiations.

In making the decision to withhold this information, the public interest considerations set out in section 9(1) of the Official Information Act were considered. At the time the Report was prepared to be published on our website, where information was withheld, no public interest was identified that would outweigh the reasons for withholding it.
