

## IPP proposals that did not progress to endorsement

## Round one - June 2025

This list includes all applications to Round one of the Infrastructure Priorities Programme (IPP) that did not progress to endorsement. This may be because they were triaged out, withdrawn by the proponent, or assessed but not endorsed.

There are several reasons why applications can be triaged out, including insufficient information, proposing a project that is not infrastructure, or speaking to local rather than a national need – the IPP is for proposals with national significance. Projects that are already receiving funding are also ineligible for the IPP.

As a result, not progressing to endorsement does not necessarily mean that a proposal does not have merit.

Applicants can reapply in future rounds if they can strengthen their proposal and it seeks to address a nationally important infrastructure need.

These proposals are listed in alphabetical order. Projects not submitted on behalf of an organisation are listed as Unaffiliated.
