A lapse in concentration is all it takes.

- Think about the maximum reach of all machinery and consider how it can be used safely.
- Plan ahead. Mark overhead and underground power cables on farm maps and inform ALL staff and visitors of where they are.
- Locate the electricity network Look up and check around you before loading or unloading, hedge cutting, using tipper wagons or trailers in fields and when stacking.
