Long working days, warm weather and tiredness can often lead you to take shortcuts at work. Follow these simple safety steps BEFORE you start work to Be Bright - Stay Safe.

- Contact UK Power Networks, or your local operator, to find out the location of cables on your land and mark them on your farm map
- Tell visitors and contractors where electricity cables are
- Plan your work be extra careful when harvesting, ploughing, using irrigation pipes and long objects
- ALWAYS look up and check around when loading or unloading vehicles, stacking materials, using tipper wagons or trailers in fields
- Know the height of your machinery and any add-ons prior to starting work
