Installation of electricity cables from Chessington – Kingston

UK Power Networks runs and operates the electricity network delivering power to your area. We are currently undertaking a project to improve and upgrade underground cables between our substations in Chessington and Kingston. The work is part of our ongoing investment in the network to maintain reliable power supplies.

Cable installation

With duct laying between our two substations almost complete, we are preparing to return to specific intervals along the full route to install joint bays where we will pull the new cables into place within the ducts and connect them to our electricity network.

The table below includes the location, date, and traffic management plan for the installation of a joint bay on Lamberts Road:

Location	Dates	Traffic Management
Opposite Villiers Path, next to King Charles Road.	7 October to 14 November 2026	Road closed at the point we are working. Access maintained for properties within closure. Signed diversion in place via Surbiton Hill Road and Cranes Park.

Access to properties will be maintained, and the site team will work with residents and businesses to understand their access and delivery needs and plan the daily works with the least disruption possible. Our working hours are from 8am to 5pm Monday to Saturday and should have no impact on your electricity supply.

Public information event

Following well attended information events in January 2026 during the duct laying phase of works, we are holding another session for residents to speak to the project team about the cable installation phase.
