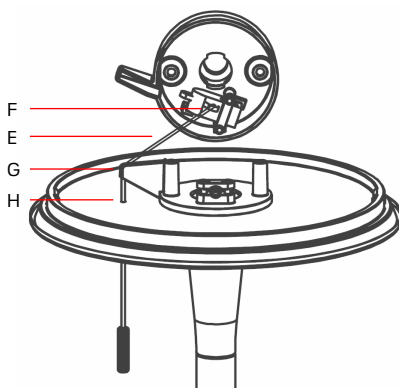
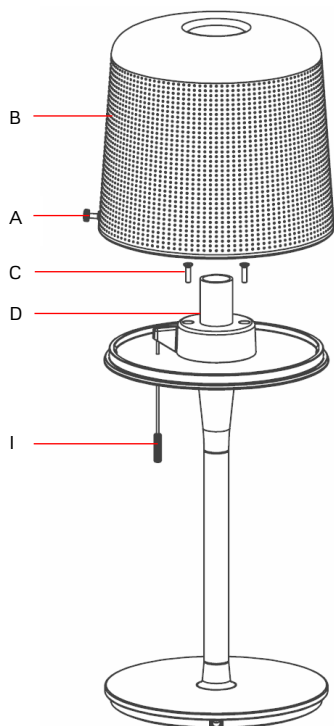


Replacement of broken pull string

ATTENTION – DISCONNECT POWER BEFORE SERVICING

Switch off the power supply before continuing with any of the steps. Qualified local assistance may be necessary to ensure correct preparation and servicing of your lamp, if in doubt, do not continue.

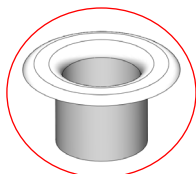
1. Loosen the finger screw (A) and remove the lamp shade (B).
2. Remove the two screws (C) from the cover (D) using a hex key, then lift and tilt (note the electrical wiring inside).
3. Remove the old pull string (E) from the switch (F).
4. Install the included eyelet in the hole in the glass to protect the new string better from sharp edges.
See opposite site for instructions on how to do this.
5. Take the new pull string (E) and tie a knot on one end and route it through the hole in the switch (F).
6. Note to place the pull string in the groove (G) and route the string through the hole in the glass (H).
7. Reposition the cover (D) while making sure that the cord stays in the groove (G). Tighten the two screws (C).
8. Take the steel knob (I) and route the string through it. Tie a knot at the end of the string.
9. Place the lamp shade (B) on the glass and tighten the finger screw (A).



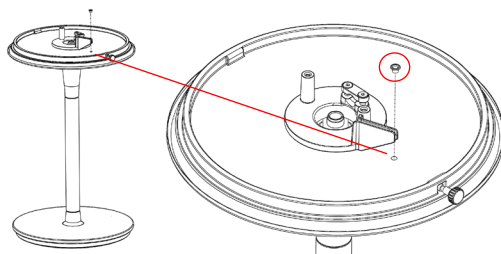
Inserting protective eyelet

Insert the included eyelet, to ensure the replacement string is not damaged by sharp edges on the inside of the glass.

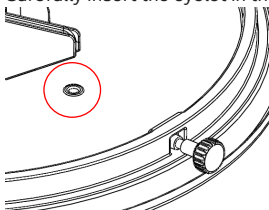
1. Locate the small, white eyelet in the bag.



2. The eyelet is to be inserted in the hole from the TOP side of the glass.



3. Put a tiny drop of transparent super glue/contact glue on the outside wall of the eyelet.
4. Carefully insert the eyelet in the hole in the glass.



5. Make sure the glue is dry before continuing the operation of inserting the new string.
